Fillingham to Lead Panel Discussion at National Association of Bond Lawyers Conference

Session Will Address Challenges in Work-Outs of Financially Distressed Deals

Ann D. Fillingham, member in Dykema's Business Services Department and a specialist in public and structured finance, will lead a panel discussion, "Anatomy of a Defaulted Deal," at the 2012 Bond Attorneys' Workshop, to be held in Chicago on October 24-26, 2012.
