Richard Bendix to Participate in American Bankruptcy Institute Webinar

With Other Panel Members Will Discuss § 1111 (b) Election, Plan Feasibility and Cramdown

On July 15, 2013, Richard M. Bendix, Jr., member and co-leader of Dykema's Bankruptcy and Restructuring Practice Group, will be a panelist in a webinar presented by the American Bankruptcy Institute. Titled "Chapter 11 Track: The § 1111 (b) Election, Plan Feasibility and Cramdown Issues," this 75-minute event—part of the ABI Live webinar series—will start at 1:00pm ET.

Using a case study, Bendix and his fellow webinar panelists—among them, a U.S. Bankruptcy Court judge—will explore a variety of issues that surround an under-secured lender's decision whether or not to make an election under § 1111 (b) regarding its claim, plan feasibility and voting. The panel will also walk attendees through the necessary mathematical analysis used to evaluate these issues.
