Richard Bendix Co-Authors Article for *Metropolitan Corporate Counsel*

The article covers a recent Second Circuit Court of Appeals decision that expanded section 546(e)'s protection for recipients of constructive fraudulent transfers in Ponzi schemes and that, notably, section 546(e) does not prevent a trustee from recovering intentional fraudulent transfers.
